We don't know much about him, but that he wants to study Geology next year. We've formed our own opinions of him and conclude that he's a real nice guy. Good luck Dave.



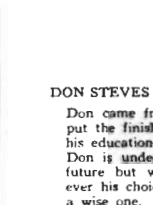
SHEILA FRAME

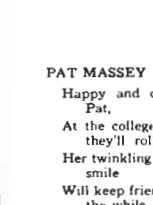
EVAN KYBA
