Your teaching of literature and composition and your guidance as our home room teacher have helped us throughout our collegiate years. Our thanks to you, Mr. Dorrett.



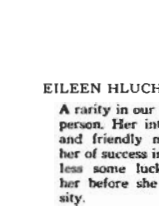
ELSIE KOLOMIETZ

M-m-m...!



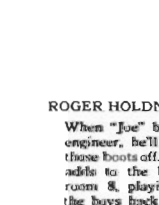
EDWIN SHENNETT

Here's a girl that's on the beam.



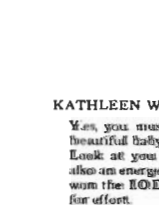
WAYNE PINKNEY
