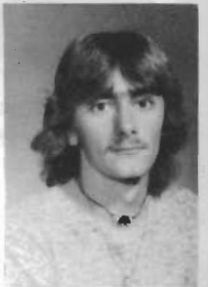
Murray Adams is now a working man with C.P. Murray played soccer during his one semester here. He plans to be the first to make a trans-Atlantic crossing in an engine.
