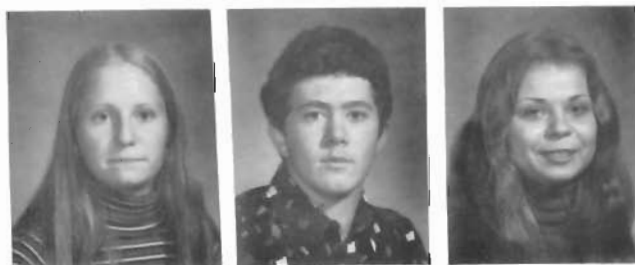
Nick Nemeth enjoys collecting stamps and science fiction paperbacks. He is going into Commerce. P.D. Being outspoken.
