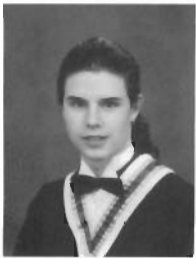




Norman McGillivray: hails from Flin Flon, eh, Debbie?
